INVITATION FOR BIDS (IFB 01)
Smallholder Agribusiness and Resilience Project - (SARP)
with the Collaboration of Department of Agrarian
Development
IFAD Loan No: 2000003227

1. The Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka has received a loan from the International Fund for Agriculture Development (IFAD) towards the cost of Smallholder Agribusiness and Resilience Project (SARP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the Contracts for the Rehabilitation Minor Irrigation Schemes under Vengala Cheddikulam and Vavuniya South Divisional Secretary Divisions in Vavuniya District.
2. The Employer (Implementation) "Department of Agrarian Development - DAD" now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the execution and completion of Rehabilitation of 7 nos. of minor irrigation scheme, which are being bid as a unit price for each and every scheme (contract) based on the bill of quantities. The details are briefed in the table below.

3. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding (NCB). To be eligible for contract award, successful bidders shall not have been blacklisted and shall meet the requirements of CIDA registration as scheduled in table above.

- A complete set of Bidding Documents in English language may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the Assistant Commissioner, Department of Agrarian Development, Vavuniya. From 08/05/2024 until 30/05/2024 from 9.00 am to 2.30

- pm upon payment of non-refundable fees of Rs 3,500.00. The method of payment should be by cash.
8. Bids must be delivered to The Chairman, District Procurement Committee, Department of Agrarian Development, Vavuniya by Registered Post or Directly put into the Tender Box on or before 2.00pm 31/05/2024. Name of work and Contract number should be mentioned in the left-hand corner of Envelop. Original and Copy of Bid have to be submitted in separate Envelops. Please note that electronic bids shall not be accepted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be opened soon after closing in the presence of the bidders or bidders' representatives who choose to attend.
 9. All Bids shall be accompanied by a Bid security in the form of Bid security included in section 9. The amount and validity of bid security shall be as per the information given in the table above.
 10. A Pre-Bid meeting will be held at the Department of Agrarian Development, Station Road, Vavuniya on 22nd May 2024 at 10.00am. Presence is not mandatory, but interested bidders are encouraged to attend. Bidders should arrange their own site visit prior to the Pre-Bid meeting.
